SUMMARY OF THERMAL TREATMENT PROJECT AND GENERAL EXPERIENCE

Co-Founder and President, TerraTherm, Inc. As President and General Manager, Mr. Bierschenk has overall responsibility for TerraTherm's general administration and operations. He is the contracting officer for the company. In this role he reviews and approves the company's primary contracts and subcontracts. In addition he is a project manager. He managed the large Southern California Edison pole yard remediation project. For this project he directed the design effort, including: modeling subsurface treatment conditions; conceptual and detailed designs; vapor and liquid treatment and discharge monitoring; construction; operation; and, confirmatory sampling programs. The California Department of Toxics Substances Control (DTSC) oversaw this project; it was completed in March of 2006.

For his former employer, ENSR Consulting, Engineering and Remediation, he was Manager of Remediation Services, a department that consisted of a group of 65 engineers, scientists and constructors. This group provided design/build/operate services for industrial and government clients.
